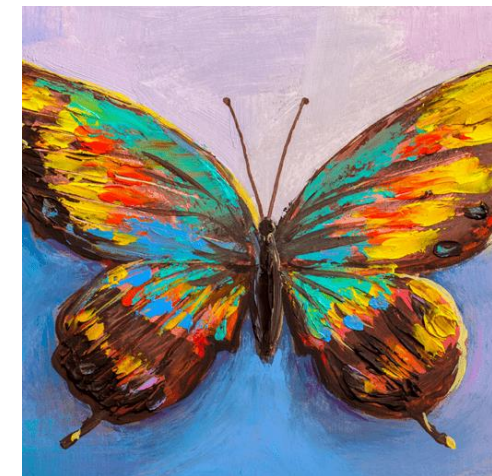
Innovate Challenge - Insect-inspired artwork
