#### **Sporting Achievements**

Riverside sports teams played over 200 fixtures this year. Impressively, the under 15 girls football team reached both the semi-finals in the Essex cup and national cup. The year 9 netball team won the borough league with an undefeated record, a superb achievement!

For the first time a Riverside student representing LBBD in the Essex Athletics Championships won gold in the 100m final, congratulations to Shalom in year 7.

Coach Onireti, following his first full year as Director of Riverside Basketball Academy noted: 'it has been an inspiring first year with over 150 students participating'. Year 7 and 8 boys both won the borough leagues, U14s girls basketball won the LBBD tournament. 16+ academy had a good first season under Coach, winning games as the season progressed. The highlight of the year was Pearl (Yr8) representing England in the Tri-Nation tournament, the first basketball player from Riverside to represent their country.
